LANGHORNE MANOR BOROUGH COUNCIL
MEETING OF DECEMBER 26, 2023

- 1. CALL TO ORDER** – the Meeting of Langhorne Manor Borough Council was called to order in the Langhorne Manor Borough Hall, 618 Hulmeville Avenue, Langhorne, Pennsylvania on December 26, 2023, at 7:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time by Nicholas Pizzola, President.

6. MOTION TO OFFER THE PART-TIME BOROUGH MANAGER POSITION TO PETER GRAY.

Council President called for a motion to offer Peter Gray the position of Borough Manager. Mr. McBeth made the motion as called for. Ms. Gasparovic seconded. There were no objections. The motion carried. Ms. Gasparovic asked if salary should be discussed in the meeting.

Council President called for an amended motion to offer Peter Gray the position of Borough Manager with a salary of \$25,000 per year for 8 hours service per week. Mr. McBeth made the motion as called for. Ms. Gasparovic seconded. There were no objections. The motion carried.

7. COMMENTS FROM RESIDENTS AND VISITORS – Mr. Grupp asked how the current salary is compared to the salary of the previous Borough Manager. Council President explained that the current offer is below the average rate for the position but reasonable with the requirements of Langhorne Manor Borough.
