## RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF LANGHORNE MANOR ESTABLISHING FILING FEES AND ESCROWS FOR APPLICATIONS AND APPEALS TO BOROUGH ZONING HEARING BOARD

Distributions from an escrow account shall be made at the exclusive direction and control of Borough Zoning Hearing Board for any and all administrative, advertising, stenographic, legal, engineering, planning and other costs incurred by the Zoning Hearing Board and Borough in connection with the subject Application or Appeal to Zoning Hearing Board. The applicant and appellant shall, as soon as fifty (50%) percent of an escrow has been disbursed, make an additional payment in such amount as necessary to restore the account to its initial amount.
