

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-0006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LANGHORNE MANOR, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FURTHER AMENDING CHAPTER 163, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III PARKING REGULATIONS, §163-125 PARKING PROHIBITED OF THE LANGHORNE MANOR BOROUGH CODE ADOPTED AS ORDINANCE NO. 95-06-01 ON JUNE 6, 1995 WHICH AMENDMENT PROVIDES FOR THE PROHIBITING OF PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF MANOR AVENUE FROM PINE STREET TO THE EAST TERMINUS OF MANOR AVENUE AND ON EAST SIDE OF PINE STREET FROM MANOR AVENUE TO FAIRVIEW AVENUE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Langhorne Manor, County of Bucks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and same is ENACTED AND ORDAINED as an Ordinance of the Borough as follows:

Chapter 163 Vehicles and Traffic, Article III Parking Regulations; §163-125 Parking Prohibited of the Code of Langhorne Manor Borough adopted as Ordinance No. 95-06-01 on June 6, 1995 and amended by Ordinance No. 95-08-01 on August 1, 1995 and by Ordinance No. 2003-001 on November 5, 2003, and Ordinance No. 2005-005 on September 6, 2005 is hereby further amended to and shall henceforth be as follows:

§163-25. Parking Prohibited.

- A. Parking is hereby prohibited on all highways in the Borough at any and all times between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. prevailing time; with the exception of the south side of Manor Avenue from the intersection thereof with Bellevue Avenue to a point fifty (50) feet west of the intersection thereof with Pine Street, at which location parking shall be permitted at all times subject to requirements and limitations set forth in Article IV of this Chapter.
- B. Parking is hereby prohibited on the following highways at all times on the sides of the highway and in the locations indicated:


Highway	Side	Location
Highland Avenue	Both	Bellevue Avenue to Station Avenue
Hulmeville Avenue	East	Highland Avenue to a point 100 feet south thereof
Manor Avenue	Both	Pine Street to East terminus of Manor Avenue
Pine Street	East	Manor Avenue to Fairview Avenue

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
