ARTICLE I Higher Education and Health Authority [Adopted 2-17-1987 as Ord. No. 1987-2]

§ 5-1. Organization. [Amended 7-10-1989 by Ord. No. 1989-3]

The Council of the Borough of Langhorne Manor (the "borough") hereby signifies and expresses its intention and desire to organize the Borough of Langhorne Manor Higher Education and Health Authority under the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, Act of May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as amended, for the purpose of acquiring, holding, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating, owning or leasing projects for health centers and buildings and facilities for private, nonprofit, nonsectarian colleges and universities, state-related universities and community colleges.

§ 5-2. Intent.

The borough deems that it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people of the area to be served by such educational facilities to have such facilities provided by an Authority.

§ 5-3. Article of Incorporation.

The Articles of Incorporation of the Borough of Langhorne Manor Higher Education Authority shall be as follows:
