

RESOLUTION NO. 2019 004

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF LANGHORNE MANOR BOROUGH,
COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A
POLICY GOVERNING THE USE OF BOROUGH PROPERTY
FOR THE PLACEMENT OF SIGNS AND SCHEDULING OF EVENTS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Langhorne Manor, Bucks County, PA owns and operates a Borough Hall, located at 618 Hulmeville Avenue, Langhorne, PA 19047; and,

WHEREAS, there has not previously been established by resolution or ordinance a policy governing signage and/or public events at Borough Hall; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of Langhorne Manor Borough has deemed it in the best interest of the public to establish a policy providing appropriate regulations relating to the posting of signs at Borough Hall as well as the usage of Borough Hall for events held by the public; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of Langhorne Manor Borough intends to enact this resolution to establish standards to protect public property owned by the Borough, as well as to benefit the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved by authority of the Council of Langhorne Manor Borough as follows.

1. No individual shall have the authority to post or install signs at 618 Hulmeville Avenue, Langhorne, PA 19047 without approval of the Council of Langhorne Manor Borough.
2. Permission shall not be granted with respect to the installation of signs at 618 Hulmeville Avenue, Langhorne, PA 19047, unless such signs pertain to Borough governance.
3. Signs installed at 618 Hulmeville Avenue, Langhorne, PA 19047 shall be wire-post only, and shall not consist of wood, plastic, or metal posts. No signs shall be larger than six (6) square feet in size. No signs shall be posted or appended directly to any building or existing structure.
4. No permanent or temporary structure may be erected on Borough property unless said structure relates to a Borough-sponsored activity, or Borough governance.
5. When an event is held at Borough Hall, it is the obligation of the individuals or entity hosting said event to make available appropriate trash receptacles and to clean all trash and debris generated on Borough property. The individuals or entity hosting the

aforesaid event shall be solely responsible to reimburse Langhorne Manor Borough for all costs incurred in association with any event.

6. Langhorne Manor Borough shall make a form available to submit an application to host an event at Borough Hall.
7. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
