**1. Approve April meeting minutes**

**2. RVE: Liz Colletti & Michael DeAngelis**

- Comly Ave project updates
- RVE grant #2 preparation proposal (Watershed Restoration) – for Council approval Tues

**3. Discussion of possible Hill Ave swale conversion – 2 blocks approaching Comly**

- Linear feet / # blocks
- Existing grassy swales / deteriorated stone swales
- Trees? Curbs?
- Cost estimate
- Updates from Bucks Conservation District
  - Approx. \$300k is available right now. Need to move fast if Council approves. Rolling funds/awards. SW projects viewed favorably. Prevailing wage must be paid on larger projects like this one.
  - Next steps:
    - Traffic count – 3 blocks of Hill Ave.
    - Application with rough sketch (hand-drawn is ok), materials, equipment, labor, engineering
    - On-site meeting with Morgan Schuster
    - QAB board approval, Conservation District approval
  - Need start/complete date, cost estimate (+30% possible later if funds are avail.)
  - 1-year from fund award to complete the project
  - Match not required, but helpful. May use Borough Manager time, volunteer time (incl. SWC), small portion of project such as seeding/mulching at the end.
- Other alternatives – raingarden in woods (NW corner Hulmeville & Comly)?

**4. Revisiting past questions/next steps:**

- Comly Ave - timeline
- Review of calculations – Growing Greener grant, initial overall LMB requirements
- Cairn University & Mill Creek Watershed
- Verification of original Rettew mapping & calculations
- NEW – L Shuke retrofit sediment controls – possible MS4 credits? Discuss w/RVE

**6. PennDOT available MS4 partnerships – from PSAB alert**

- Option 1 - Use of PennDOT vendor (Working Lands), negotiate price per pound, typically stream restoration credits. Vendor maintains facility. Borough writes a check, partners with vendor, listed as 3<sup>rd</sup> party on PennDOT contract.
- Option 2 - RC3 service road removal – no final plans yet, PennDOT to provide later. Credits for next MS4 cycle (2027 onward)?
