- New federal funding will be available soon, perhaps can be applied towards SWC (from NCRS – Natural Resource Conservation Service, NOAA, etc.)
- Discussion of RVE estimate of funding for Comly project, despite no final project design or sketches
- SWC felt that having RVE representative(s) at the next SWC is an important step to answer our questions & clarify direction
- L Shuke retrofitting property for sediment control. To discuss potential MS4 credits with RVE.

- New RVE partners – Need for SWC to clarify past work of SWC **including recommendation to preserve stone swales**
