1. Approve August meeting minutes – approved with no changes

2. Recap of recommended MS4 plan/Council approval

- Approximate timeline of next steps was discussed (grant applications/due dates, construction timelines for Comly and Swale projects), based on discussions with RVE.
 - Traffic Counts on Pine & Prospect - **Sept or Oct 2022**
 - WRPP Grant decision (Note: LMB did not receive this grant) – **end of Oct 2022**
 - SWC newsletter – **Nov or Dec 2022**

 - Growing Greener grant can be applied for again if needed (we received funding from this once already) – **approx. June 2023**
 - WRPP can be applied for again if needed – **approx. May 2023**

 - RVE to design swale project – **first half of 2023**
 - Swale project bidding - **by end of 2023 or early 2024**
 - Swale project construction – **2024**
 - Swale project to be completed – **Nov/Dec 2024 (possibly into early 2025)**

3. Traffic counts for Prospect and Pine? – Jim (Prospect Ave) and Alicia (Pine St) to complete Tues 9/27 – Thurs 9/29 between 3 and 5 pm. (Note that Jim actually completed both streets. Thank you Jim!)

4. Next newsletter? Lauren to assist with. We hope to mail physical copies this time, with mailed postcard announcements as a runner-up alternative.

5. Discussion of SWC meeting frequency going forward Currently much of the work is being completed by RVE with minimal input from the SWC needed, and so SWC meetings can be less frequent for a while.

6. Group celebration of another major milestone? Sat Oct 1, 2-4pm, outside at Jim's house was proposed (Note that this event eventually was postponed until 2023 tbd)
