

**MINUTES  
LANGHORNE MANOR BOROUGH COUNCIL  
MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 19, 2017**

**1. CALL TO ORDER** - The meeting of Langhorne Manor Borough was called to order in the Langhorne Manor Borough Hall, 618 Hulmeville Avenue, Langhorne, Pennsylvania, on Tuesday, September 19, 2017 at 8; 00 P.M. Eastern Time by William McTigue, President.

At this point in the meeting, Mr. Hanisco led us in the “Pledge of Allegiance.”

Mr. McTigue spoke about a change order for replacing the side walk along the administration building up to the bilco door at a cost of \$6,500 and to extend it to the new police facility the cost will be \$8,500. Motion was made by Ms. Gimpel and seconded by Mrs. Seader to extend the walk to the new police facility at a cost of \$8,500. No objections were presented. Motion carried.

Mr. McTigue reported that the grant application for \$100,000 has to be signed by Hulmeville Borough as they are the one obtaining the grant.

Mr. McTigue reported on Resolution NO. 2017-004 of Langhorne Manor, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, authorizing application as a subgrantee for Hulmeville Borough to the Bucks County Redevelopment Authority for a municipal grant under Act 71 of 2004, as amended.

Motion was made by Mr. Ferraro and seconded by Ms. Gimpel to adopt Resolution NO. 2017-004 as presented by Mr. McTigue. No objections were presented. Motion carried.

Mr. Pizzola stated that he had contacted PennDot and the Delaware Valley Planning Commission to try and get a traffic study of the borough streets.

Mr. Pizzola reported that Jason Snyder is coming out to do a road survey.

**10. ADJOURNMENT** – Mr. McTigue entertained a motion to adjourn this meeting. Motion was made by Mr. Ferraro and seconded by Ms. Gimpel to adjourn this meeting. No objections were presented. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:25 P.M.
