

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01
BOROUGH OF LANGHORNE MANOR
BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**A RESOLUTION OF LANGHORNE MANOR BOROUGH, BUCKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE PURPOSE AND DUTIES OF THE
LANGHORNE MANOR BOROUGH STORMWATER COMMISSION.**

WHEREAS, the Council of Langhorne Manor (the “borough”) established the Langhorne Manor Borough Stormwater Commission (the “Commission”) on July 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Langhorne Manor wishes to establish the purpose and duties of the Commission,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Borough Council of Langhorne Manor Borough, Bucks County, Pennsylvania as follows:

ARTICLE I – ORGANIZATION

SECTION 1: This Resolution shall be known as and may be called the Langhorne Manor Borough Stormwater Commission Resolution.

ARTICLE II – AUTHORITY AND SELECTION

SECTION 1: Selection

a) The Commission will consist of one (1) Borough Council member acting as chair and six (6) borough residents - all of whom will serve without compensation.

b) The commission will remain established until the fulfillment of Article II, Sections 2a and 2b, or until the first Borough Council meeting in January of 2025, whichever occurs first. The Borough Council will also have the authority to discharge the Commission at will for convenience at any time during or after the said term. At such time, if the Borough Council so desires, Council shall appoint two (2) resident members to serve terms of one (1) year, two (2) resident members shall be appointed to serve terms of two (2) years, and two (2) resident members shall be appointed to serve terms of three (3) years, such that two (2) resident commission members’ terms expire each year.

c) At expiration of each of the terms described in Article II, Section 1b, two (2) resident members shall be appointed to the Commission each year, to serve terms of three (3) years.

d) If a vacancy occurs during the term of a Commissioner, a successor shall be appointed by Borough Council to serve the balance of the unexpired term.

SECTION 2: While the Commission exists, the Borough Council shall direct the Commission as follows:

a) The Commission shall, in consultation with the Borough Manager, recommend to Borough Council all specific project options deemed most appropriate and beneficial, outlining the scope of work, initial cost, maintenance requirements, long term costs, resident impact, potential funding/grant sources and amounts, and PA Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) recognized credits at a minimum. The recommendation should also include any and all professional services fees necessary to accomplish the proposed in order to fulfill the borough's MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System) requirements as set forth by the PA Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP).

c) The Commission shall participate in the education of the borough community on stormwater and directly related environmental matters.
