

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-14**  
**A RESOLUTION OF THE LANGHORNE BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**IMPOSING A REFUSE COLLECTION CHARGE**

WHEREAS, the Langhorne Manor Borough Council is a legal government entity as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with certain corporate powers, including but not limited to the power to provide for the collection and removal of refuse material; and

WHEREAS, the Langhorne Manor Borough Council has accepted the bid and will enter into a contract with Republic Services of Pennsylvania, LLC concerning the collection of non-recyclable refuse and recyclable refuse and bulk rubbish collection; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that:

1. **Levy of Refuse Collection and Disposal Assessment.** A refuse collection and disposal assessment of Four hundred, nineteen and 00/100 (\$419.00) Dollars is hereby levied and assessed against each residential dwelling unit, including apartments, guest houses and servants quarters situate within the Borough from which refuse is collected pursuant to the Refuse Collection Contract of the Borough as provided for in the Borough Code, Act of February 1, (1966) 1965. P.L. 1656, No. 581 Cl.08 Reenacted and amended May 17, 2012, P.L. 262 No. 43 1201 et seq., and reenacted and further amended by Act 37 of 2014, as amended. Said assessment shall be collected as provided by law and shall not be subject to discount for early payment, but all taxpayers who shall fail to make payment of said assessment within four (4) months after the date of assessment notice shall be charged a penalty of ten (10%) percent.
2. **Repealer.** All provisions or parts of Ordinances of the Borough conflicting with or inconsistent with this Resolution shall be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as same are affected by this Resolution.


